**Masses:**

Every Sunday 4pm,

confessions 3.15-3.45pm on the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of the month;  
 no confessions before Mass on 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of the month.

Confessions **after** each Sunday Mass for as long as necessary, no limit.

(Missa Cantata every 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday; Low Mass every other Sunday).

Weekday Masses: Wednesday and Friday 7pm; confessions 6.15-6.45pm.

**Receiving Holy Communion:** [This] Pontifical Commission would like to point out that the celebration of Holy Mass in the Extraordinary Form envisages the reception of Holy Communion while kneeling, as the Sacred Host is laid directly on the tongue of the communicant. There is no provision for the distribution of Holy Communion on the hand in this Form of the Holy Mass. [From the Secretariat of the Pontifical Commission "Ecclesia Dei". Vatican 21/6/2010].

**Holy Week Schedule 2019:**

Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> April, Palm Sunday Missa Cantata 4pm – meet at the Lourdes Grotto outside for the Procession;! However, for inclement weather meet in the Refectory instead for the blessing of Palms and procession)

Fig Monday (no Extraordinary Form Mass today)

Requiem Mass of Msgr Hugh Canon McNally at 12noon on Monday 15 April in St. Andrew's Cathedral followed by burial at Balgay Cemetery (Priests' plot) at 2pm

Holy Tuesday: 6am Low Mass in Our Lady of Victories Church (enter by the blue side door at Powrie Place)

the Chrism Mass is on Spy Wednesday at 7pm in St Andrew's Cathedral;

(therefore no 7pm EF Wednesday Mass here in the convent)

Maundy Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> April: Missa Cantata Mass 7pm; Adoration at the altar of repose until Midnight.

Good Friday 19<sup>th</sup> April Sung Passion of the Lord 3pm,  
 (please arrive EARLY as late comers disturb the silence of 3pm)

Good Friday Stations of the Cross 8pm;

Saturday Easter Vigil 20<sup>th</sup> April Missa Cantata 10pm; (Blessing of the Holy Fire outside on the car park side)

Easter Sunday Low Mass 4pm.

**Extra confession times:** Please note all extra times are contingent on Fr Doohan not being called away for the last rites at the hospitals, your understanding of the priority for the dying is very much appreciated.

**No confessions before Mass on Palm Sunday, but for as long as necessary after Holy Mass.**

Maundy Thursday: 6pm-6.45pm and eventually after Mass for as long as necessary (which involves the reposition of the Blessed Sacrament to the Altar of Repose, and the stripping of the altars).

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament at the Altar of Repose (in the refectory, converted into a temporary chapel) will conclude at Midnight, so anyone wishing to obtain confession need only alert Father Doohan who will gladly then proceed to the confessional.

Good Friday: Father Doohan will be in the chapel from 1pm onwards for confession requests, and in the confessional box from 2pm-2.45pm. Confessions afterwards for as long as necessary.  
Confessions after the Stations of the Cross also for as long as necessary.

Holy Saturday: 9-9.45pm

Easter Sunday: any penitent may request confessions after the Easter Vigil.

Otherwise confessions 3.15-3.45pm and after Sunday Mass for as long as necessary.

**Children's Confessions:** Children will always have preference over adults in the confession queue.

**Future Second Collections:** Good Friday (19<sup>th</sup> April), for the Holy Places; Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> May, for the Apostolate of Communications; Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> June for the Apostolate of Life; Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> June for Peter's Pence.
