(Missa Cantata every 2nd and 4th Sunday; Low Mass every other Sunday).

Weekday Masses: Wednesday and Friday 7pm; confessions 6.15-6.45pm.

Receiving Holy Communion: [This] Pontifical Commission would like to point out that the celebration of Holy Mass in the Extraordinary Form envisages the reception of Holy Communion while kneeling, as the Sacred Host is laid directly on the tongue of the communicant. There is no provision for the distribution of Holy Communion on the hand in this Form of the Holy Mass. [From the Secretariat of the Pontifical Commission "Ecclesia Dei". Vatican 21/6/2010].

N.B. At the Latin Mass no blessings are conferred on the faithful at the altar rail, in place of receiving Holy Communion.

Those unable to receive at this time, for whatever reason, are invited to make a spiritual Holy Communion kneeling in their pew.

St Theresa, the Little Flower, relics come to Dundee: 4th-7th September, in St Andrew's Cathedral.

(Ordinary Form of the Roman Rite)

*Wednesday 4th 7pm Arrival of the Relics, followed by Holy Mass with Bishop Robson. Homily given by Canon John Udris of Oscott College. Veneration of the relics will be possible until 9pm. **There will also be the traditional blessing of roses during this Holy Mass, devotees are invited to bring their roses to be blessed** (there will be limited opportunity to buy them that evening in the Cathedral porch), and leave them as a votive offering to St Therese at her reliquary, take home as a sacramental, or bring to a pilgrim who could not be there because they are housebound.

*Thursday 5th 10am Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Lauds. 1pm Mass. 7pm Vespers, Benediction,

All night vigil at the Cathedral; open throughout the night Thur to Friday: Fr Doohan at 3am leads the Rosary.

*Friday 6th 10am Exposition & Lauds. 1pm Mass. 7pm Holy Hour with Canon Udris. 9pm Compline and close.

*Saturday 7th September 10am Choral Mass followed by opportunity for veneration of the relics until the 4pm departure.

Annual Diocesan Vocations Mass: (Ordinary Form of the Roman Rite) St Andrew's Cathedral Thursday 12th September 7pm. Please do join in our prayer for vocations, particularly the vocation to the priesthood in the presbyterate of the Diocese of Dunkeld. Sermon given by Father Jean Gove, a recently ordained Maltese Priest who assists at weekends in St Mary's Locher whilst studying at St Andrews University. *Lord send us Priests! Lord send us good and holy Priests!*

Advance notice of absence: Father Doohan will be absent from the Diocese during the month of November visiting family in Australia, assisting his grandmother to visit her sister on her 100th Birthday. This means that all the Sundays in November will be offered by another Priest. The Holyday of Obligation Mass for All Saints will be offered on Friday 1st November at 7pm by the Lord Bishop, who will also offer a Requiem at 12 Noon for All Souls on Saturday 2nd of November. There will be no weekday Masses during this period of absence, however the daily Holy Mass offered by Father Doohan whilst overseas (almost always in the old rite) will be for the intentions of the Holy Souls given by his Parishioners at Pope St Pius X Parish, and also members of our own Sacred Heart TLM Community, as is the custom in this diocese. November List envelopes for lists of the deceased, and donations for these month long Masses will be made available in advance. Apologies for the reduction in Holy Masses during this period.

Secondary Mass intention: at each Holy Mass a Priest may offer the Sacrifice of Calvary for a specific intention. When the lay faithful request the fruit of the Mass to be applied principally for a particular end, they make this known and provide a Mass stipend for this purpose. Priests are also allowed to retain a secondary personal intention for each Mass, with or without stipend. From 15/8/16 to 14/8/17 I dedicated this to the Holy Souls in Purgatory; 2017-2018 Canonisation of Father Willie Doyle SJ; 2018-2019 Canonisation of Mother Yvonne

Aimee de Jesus. Now from 2019-2020 the intention will be for the canonisation of Father Alexander Cameron SJ. At every Holy Mass this year, both in the Ordinary and the Extraordinary Form, I shall offer my secondary intention for the book of petitions (at the back of Church) which looks to his beatification and canonisation. At every memento of the Roman Canon therefore your petitions committed to this book of intentions will have its place at the Altar. **Blessed be God in His Angels and in His Saints.** *Father Ninian Doohan*
